THIS WEEK'S LEARNING


In our group bubbles we have continued to learn about the new routines that keep us safe and our learning has included daily English and Maths as well as debates about fairness and justice at this difficult time.



Group J have been designing their own dream houses and drawing the pictures. Also included is a photograph of the children participating in the daily mile.




'Group G went on a nature walk to collect leaves as a part of our Art lesson, 'Leaf printing'.
