REMINDER

For the time being please do remember the following:

Drop off is between 8:30-9:00 and gates will close at 9:00. We are not expecting children to be late as we are limiting access to main reception

Nursery and Reception parents can take their child to the classroom door in the mornings

Next week, we will continue to bring Year 1 children in via the Lower Hall

All children in years 2-6 need to walk into school via the Children Centre Gate or Community Centre gate without an adult and staff will supervise

Collection at the end of the day needs to be prompt and one adult per child is permitted to collect. Please do not linger on site or on Bury Avenue

We are unable to accept any belongings so please ensure your child has everything they need when you drop off

The dining room will be open so hot meals are available. All children in Reception and KS1 are entitled to a meal and all payments for KS2 meals can be made via ParentPay

If you have any questions please email these in and avoid asking staff on the gates as the priority is to ensure the safe entry and exit of all children.

Values Ambassadors

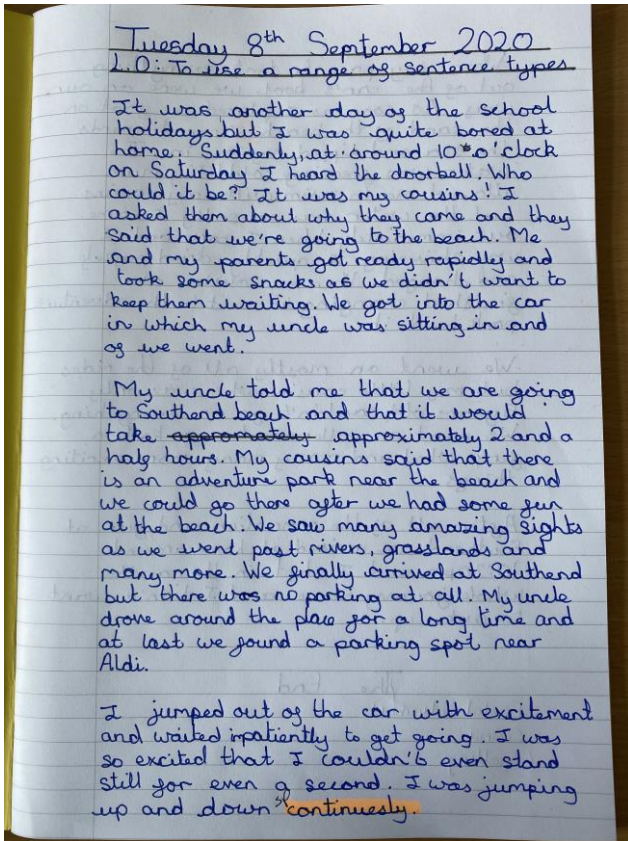
