## Google Classroom



This week we issued a letter regarding our learning platform: Google Classroom. There are currently no plans to close schools but we are preparing in the event of the guidance changing.

All schools have a duty, from next week to be prepared for remote learning in the event of:

- Class or Year Group Isolation following a positive COVID test result at school
- Local Lockdown
- National Lockdown
- In the event of any of the above learning will be loaded onto Google Classroom and your child will need their individual login, which will be issued via Class Dojo next week.

Each child from Reception to Year 6 will be expected to:

- Read daily for a minimum of 10 minutes
- Complete the activities issued as part of the pre-recorded lessons that teachers will upload. These will include a Phonics or spelling lesson and task, a Maths task, a Writing task and a subject specific task
- Join the daily group feedback sessions which will be set by the class teacher and held live on Google Classroom.

Senior Leaders are able to answer any questions you may have and we ask for your continued support as we adjust to learning in this way.
