Dear Parents / Carers,

Regarding: Re-opening of the school

Following the Prime Minister's announcement on 30th December, the Government has provided a Contingency Framework for primary schools where the rates are rising rapidly. Hillingdon is included as part of this framework and we have been instructed to provide remote learning for our children up until the 18th January when the provision will be reviewed. Therefore we will be using Google Classrooms to deliver pre-recorded lessons for the morning and then feedback sessions in the afternoon.

Children who have an Education Healthcare Plan (EHCP), or have an allocated Social Worker are still expected to attend school from **Tuesday 5th January** as Monday 4th January is a Staff Inset Day.

Children of critical workers can come to school and will be taught in year group bubbles. Attendance for these children is expected up until 18th January. The following is a link for you to complete by 3pm on Monday 4th January for your child to come to school if you are a critical worker:

Breakfast Club and After School Cast Club will continue to provide the wraparound care for the children who are eligible to be in school.

Children who are eligible to come into school can arrive between 8.30 and 8.50am via their usual entrance however the Langdale gate will be closed to limit the number of gates that need to be open. We apologise if this causes you any inconvenience.

All Reception and KS1 children as well as children in KS2 who are eligible for Free School Meals are entitled to a hot lunch. We will provide a take away version of our hot meal provision for those parents/carers who require this, on a daily basis, for the children who are learning remotely. The following is a link that you can use to order the lunches and they then need to be collected from the school reception between 11.30am and 12.00 only. Please complete the form accordingly by 3pm on Monday 4th January if a meal is required:
