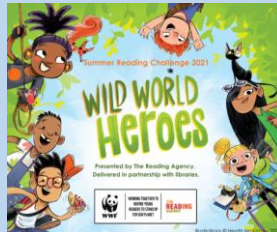
Today marks the end of the first half of summer term.
