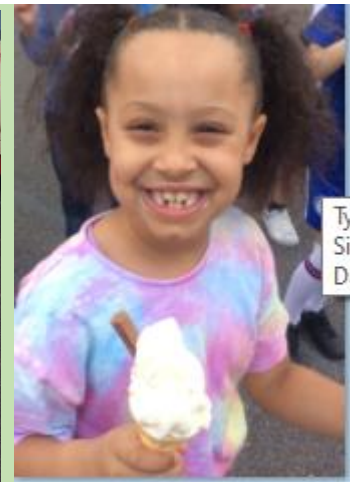
Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July- Year 6 Leavers' Prom at school with arrival from 6:45
