SCHOOL UNIFORM



It has been great to see the children back in school in their fresh new uniforms. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you that our uniform is as follows:

Charville jumper or cardigan (available from our website)

Charville Tie (elastic for Reception and KS1/ clip on for KS2 and available on our website)

White shirt (not polo t-shirt)

Black knee length skirt, black pinafore, black trousers or black shorts

White socks or black tights

Black school shoes

Black or green hijabs

Black or green hair accessories and no large hair bows

Stud earrings only

PE KIT: Plain black shorts / black leggings, plain white round neck t-shirt, plain black tracksuit and plimsolls or trainers.

PLEASE NOTE:

No summer dresses, no black trainers or boots to be worn instead of school shoes, no nail varnish and only jewellery of religious significance. No SMART watches.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance this week has been affected by a small number of children moving out of the area and awaiting new school places as well as the half day transition for Reception into school.

We will publish the weekly attendance from next week onwards and ask for your support to achieve at least 95% overall attendance for your child.

If your child presents with COVID symptoms please keep them at home and book a PCR test. Any siblings, without symptoms, are now able to attend school as normal and only need to isolate if they then have COVID symptoms.

COFFEE MORNING



Coffee morning returns next week (on Wednesday at 9.00 am) and for the first time since March 2020 these will be held in the lower hall.

We will be in the lower hall as usual from drop off so please come and join us if you can. We look forward to welcoming many of you then.

After School Club (CAST Club)

Following close monitoring before and during the pandemic we made the very difficult decision to close our after school wrap around care provision at the end of summer term. Numbers had significantly declined and most children using this were only attending on odd days rather than the whole week. Spaces were available for £4 for collection before 4:15 and £8 for a whole session.

We would like to be able to reopen this provision at the same price but in order to do so we need:

A minimum of between 12-16 children to attend per evening to ensure it does not run at a loss.

We currently have a very small number of families that indicated they would need this provision. If you would require this provision on a regular basis each night please email office@charvilleacademy.org
