As mentioned in last week's newsletter, we are planning for Christmas performances to be live. - making threats
- name calling
- cyberbullying - bullying via mobile phone or online (for example email, social networks and instant messenger)

We will also be spreading messages to be kind and to celebrate the fact that we are all different. During the week, we will be selling anti-bullying wristbands for the children to purchase for £1.00.



Monday 15th November will be Odds Socks Day - The children will wear their uniform but they can wear odd socks.

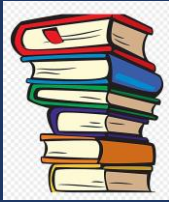
