This year, in all Christmas shows and performances we will be collecting for Halo. They are a child bereavement charity based in Hillingdon who support families that have been affected by the loss of a child.

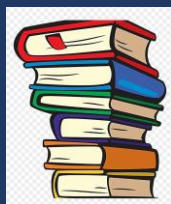
There will be a collection at the end of every show and we thank you in advance for your generosity.

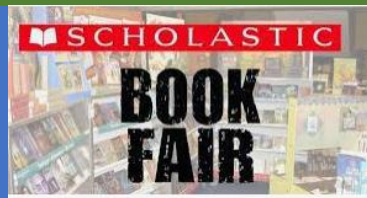
Attendance
