### Changes to COVID Testing

**On Monday the rules around testing are changing.**

If you have NO symptoms of COVID but test positive on a Lateral Flow test you are NOT required to book a PCR test but must isolate for 5 days. You are then required to retest on the morning of Day 6 and if the Lateral Flow is negative your isolation ends. If the test is positive you are required to continue to isolate and keep testing.

If you have COVID symptoms and test positive on a Lateral Flow test you are still required to book a PCR and keep us informed.
