PLEASE, REMEMBER...



On Monday of this week, the guidance around COVID testing changed.

If you have no symptoms and test positive on the lateral flow you are no longer required to take a PCR but you do have to isolate.

If you do have symptoms and test positive you are still required to book a PCR.

Isolation is now 5 days. On day 5 and day 6 you are required to take a lateral flow test and if both are negative your isolation ends.

If either are positive you are required to keep retesting and follow government guidance.

If your child is considered to be a close contact of a positive case you will be informed. Your child should then take a daily lateral flow for 7 days and can continue to come to school unless they test positive.

Please keep us informed.

School Meals

Please remember all children in Reception and KS1 are entitled to a free school meal every day.

We ask that you look at the menu and encourage your child to take up their entitlement.

If your child attends Nursery all day (30 hrs) they are also able to have a hot lunch and these are payable on ParentPay. If you have any questions please do ask.
