It has been a truly unprecedented time for us all and we all hope that this marks the start of a journey towards normality.

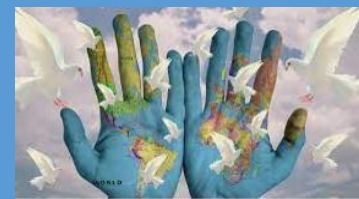
## Earrings

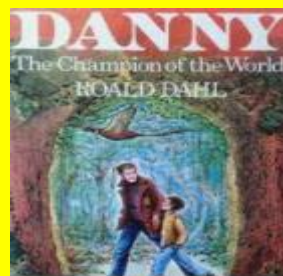
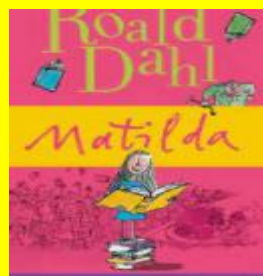
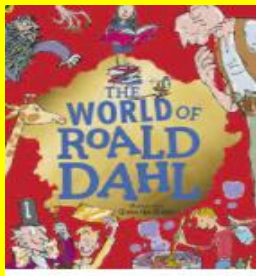
## Pancake Sale
