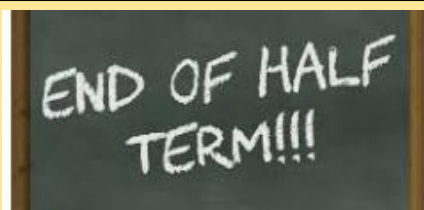
End of Term Newsletter - 1 April 2022

95% of parents strongly agree or agree that their child is happy at school.

95% of parents strongly agree or agree that their child is safe at this school.

95% of parents strongly agree or agree that the school has high expectations of their child.

Areas that we can improve further include:

86% of parents strongly agree or agree that when concerns are raised they are dealt with. We would like to see this percentage rise and would appreciate any further feedback.

91% strongly agree or agree that the school makes them aware of what their child is learning and we are aiming for this to improve.

Huge thanks go to the PTA and in particular, Nicola, for sourcing and wrapping the prizes, which looked sensational.

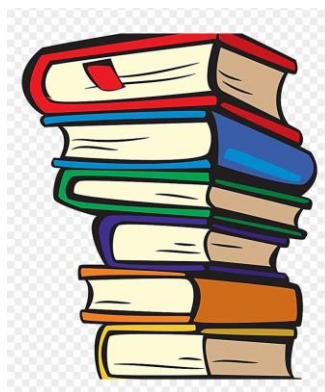
Reading Certificate

At Charville we believe that English is the foundation of the children's curriculum throughout the school.

To promote this we installed a Reading Vending Machine in our canteen. The vending machine works like any other with the exception that it is filled with books!
