Thanks to all the staff that accompanied the children and to the teachers that organised the visit.



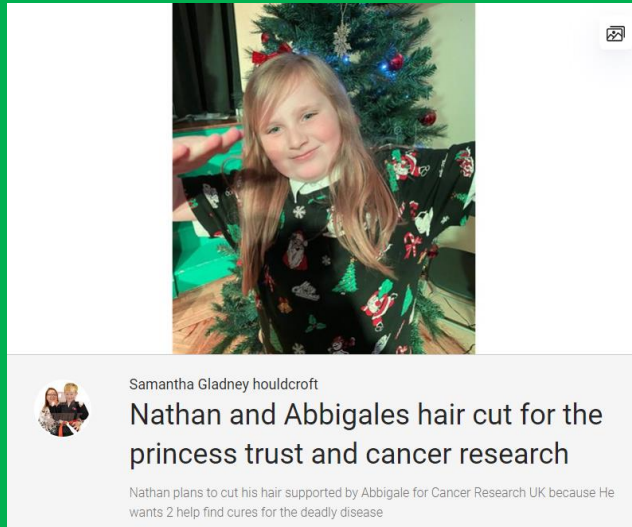
