**Attendance this week has been varied and affected by holiday being taken in term time. Please remember that attendance is a whole school priority and we are expected to achieve at least 95% across the year**

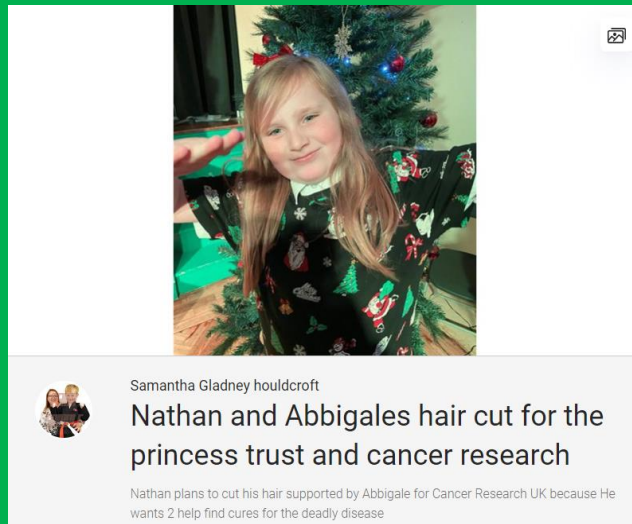
