Friday 22nd July - End of term. School closes at 1:30 and there is no afternoon Nursery session.

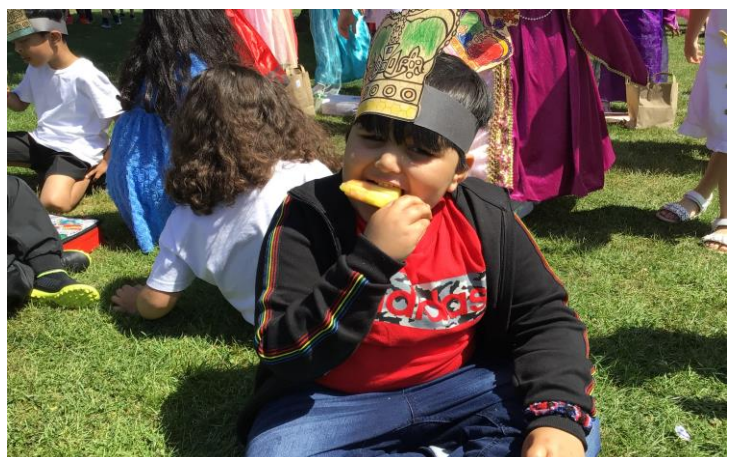
The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebration at Charville

Today Year 6 left for their PGL residential trip. We wish them all a great weekend of fun and activities and hope the sun shines for them.

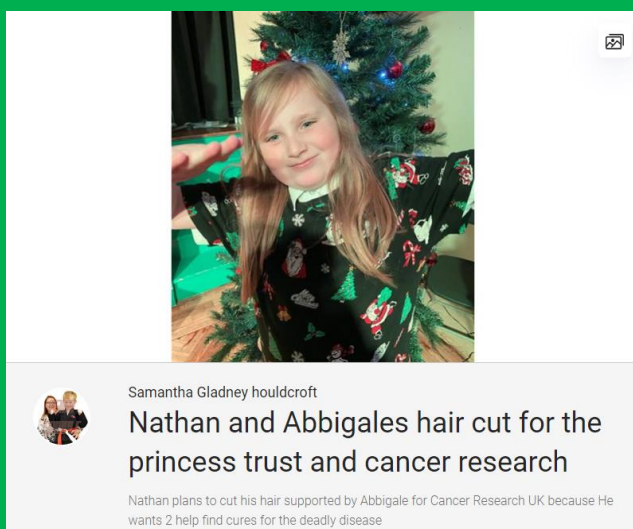
Mrs Madar will be updating our school Facebook page at the end of each day. We will do our very best to ensure that you are kept updated in this way.
