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Dear Parents/Carers

It fills me with pride to be able to write to you today to share our results for end of Key Stage 2 Assessments (SATs).

Pupils completed tests in Maths, Reading and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling. The scores from the tests in Maths and Reading are used in conjunction with Teacher Assessments for their Writing. This then gives a combined score. This is an important score which is used to benchmark schools across the country.

I am therefore elated to be able to share that our Combined score for Reading, Writing & Maths is at 76% which is significantly higher than the national average of 59%. This means that 76% of our children attained expected of above in all three subjects which is a very special achievement.

A further breakdown shows that the school out-performed other schools nationally in Reading, Writing, Maths and Grammar.
