As this is the first newsletter of the academic year I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a very happy new year and all the best for 2023.

We have welcomed a number of new children to school since we reopened and look forward to getting to know all the new families.

Our New Behaviour Policy



Our Behaviour Policy has been reviewed and there are a number of changes in order to further support how we promote positive behaviour and how we address any behaviours that are not in line with our expectations.

This policy has been approved by the Governors and shared with all the children.

All children have been shown what positive behaviour looks like and this is supported with a poster that explains these behaviours; these posters are displayed in classrooms.

We have introduced a card system so the children have a visual reminder of their behaviour. The aim is to remain on green and not move onto a yellow card or a red card.

There are now four clear categories of behaviours that are not in line with expectations and these are defined as C1, C2, C3 and C4. C1 would be regarded as low-level disruption and C4 would be the highest level of negative behaviour and includes disrespectful behaviour towards staff.

The full Behaviour Policy is included in this newsletter and we do encourage you to read the information included so that you are aware of our expectations and the consequences of behaviour that is not what we would expect.

There will be a parent/ carer coffee morning on **Wednesday 25th January at 9am** in the Lower Hall to explain the policy in more detail.
