Industrial Action Update

25th January 2023

Dear Parents / Carers

I am writing to inform you that we expect the NEU Industrial Action to go ahead on Wednesday 1st February.

As I said in the letter issued on the 19th January the classes listed in this letter are closed as their teachers have informed me they will be striking.

If your child is in one of these classes and you are a critical worker and are working on the 1st of February and have no alternative childcare we will be able to consider (on a case by case basis) if we can offer your child a place on that day.

Please note that we will not be able to guarantee that the place offered will be in their year group and therefore we will not be able to provide their formal education.

If you require this provision please email us at office@charvilleacademy.org by no later than 12 noon on Friday 27th January. If we do not hear from you we will be unable to offer the place as staffing will have been based on the number of requests.

Please note that any NEU members are not required to inform their employer if they are taking action. This means we could have classes, in addition to the classes listed above. If I am required close classes at short notice on the 1st February and this affects your child's class you will receive a phone call asking you to come and collect.

All other children not affected by strike action are expected to attend. If the strikes are averted we will be open to all children on these days as normal.
