## Time to Talk



In the absence of Place2Be we are introducing Time to Talk.

This is an opportunity for children to have time in the school day to talk, outside of the classroom, about their feelings, worries and concerns.

This is being led by Ms Roy and was introduced to the children in assembly on Monday.

Children who want to make use of this are asked to “self-refer” as it is important that it comes from the child rather than a referral from the teacher.
