## Industrial Action

22<sup>nd</sup> February 2023

Dear Parents / Carers

I am writing to inform you that the National Education Union (NEU) has voted to take industrial action. The next planned day for strike action for London schools is Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March.

As a result, we will have a partial school closure on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March** which means the following classes will be closed:

- Tudor
- York
- Georgian
- Stuart

If your child is in one of these classes and you are a critical worker and are working on the 2<sup>nd</sup> March and have no alternative childcare we will be able to consider (on a case by case basis) if we can offer your child a place on that day.

Please note that we will not be able to guarantee that the place offered will be in their year group and therefore we will not be able to provide their formal education.

If you require this provision please email us at [office@charvilleacademy.org](mailto:office@charvilleacademy.org) by no later than 12 noon on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February. If we do not hear from you we will be unable to offer the place as staffing will have been based on the number of requests.

Please note that any NEU members are not required to inform their employer if they are taking action. This means we could have classes, in addition to the classes listed above. If I am required to close classes at short notice on the 2<sup>nd</sup> March and this affects your child's class you will receive a phone call asking you to come and collect.

**All other children not affected by strike action are expected to attend.** If the strike is averted we will be open to all children on this day as normal. We will communicate separately and directly with those parent/carers who have responsibility for children deemed as vulnerable.



No after school clubs are affected so clubs on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March will go ahead.

All KS2 children (in the above classes) eligible for Free School Meals, are able to request a packed lunch. This will be sent home at the day before the day of strike action. If you would like your child to be provided with a packed lunch for the strike day please let us know by 12 noon on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February by emailing [Office@charvilleacademy.org](mailto:Office@charvilleacademy.org).
