



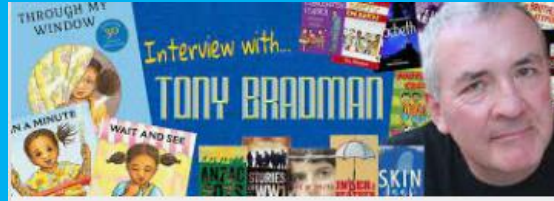

Today Tony Bradman came to school. All children had a workshop today as part of this event and Tony was able to share his inspiration and ideas.

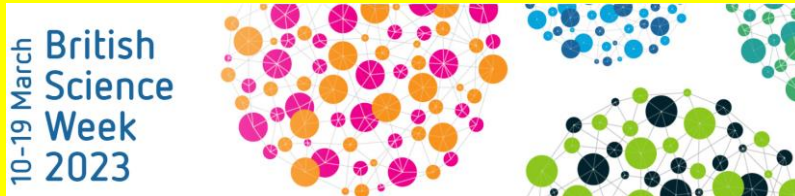
Thank you to parents and carers that purchased one or more of the books and attended the book signing.
