If you have any questions please speak to the Year 6 staff.

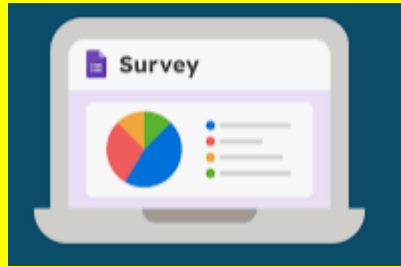
### Communications

Thank you to all that recently completed our online parent/ carer survey. We have considered all responses and have summarised the feedback given:

| Statement   | % strongly agree or agree | % disagree or strongly disagree | % that neither agree nor disagree |
|---|---------------------------|---------------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| The school is led and well managed                  | 92%                       | 3%                              | 5%                                |
| The school is friendly and welcoming                | 91%                       | 0%                              | 9%                                |
| The school helps me to support my child's learning  | 85%                       | 3%                              | 12%                               |
| My child knows who to approach if they have a worry | 83%                       | 0%                              | 17%                               |
| My child enjoys school                              | 87%                       | 5%                              | 8%                                |
| I am well informed about my child's subjects        | 91%                       | 3%                              | 6%                                |
| I know how my child is progressing                  | 91%                       | 4%                              | 5%                                |
| My child is making good progress                    | 93%                       | 4%                              | 3%                                |

We do acknowledge that throughout the survey a very small percentage of our families disagreed or strongly disagreed with the statements.

As the survey gave the option to protect anonymity it is not possible to gather further feedback and address concerns.
