Dear Parents / Carers

RE: YEAR 3 Educational Visit to Verulamium Museum

As part of our topic on the Romans, we have organised a trip to the Verulamium Museum on **Thursday 19th October 2023**. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to explore the Verulamium Museum, where they can study some of the finest Roman mosaics and wall plasters outside of the Mediterranean. They will attend specialist workshops, where they will have the opportunity to handle artefacts and learn more about Roman life. We will also be visiting a hypocaust showcasing one of the country's first heating systems.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9am and returning by approximately 3.00pm. We will update you via a text message if we will be returning later than 3.10pm due to traffic. Please ensure your child arrives at school at 8.40am on the day.

The children will require a packed lunch (no glass containers, fizzy drinks or chocolate products) contained in a named carrier bag, a waterproof jacket/coat and sensible shoes. **School uniform must be worn.** If your child requires a travel sickness tablet for the trip, please ensure this is sent in to school to the Welfare room prior to the trip.

The cost of the visit, including the workshop (travelling by coach, fitted with seat belts) will be **£17.00** per child. **Payment for the trip should be made via Parent Pay by Friday 13th October.** If insufficient money is collected through voluntary contributions, the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. You will be required to give consent through Parent Pay and you will be asked to do this before you pay. Please do not send any money into school for this trip.
