

Autumn Term Curriculum Booklet



English

This term in English we will be covering: A narrative fiction piece based on our key text 'The Egyptian Princess'. With an emphasis on suspense writing, focussing on the chase section and descriptive techniques when describing the scenery. We will be including speech and looking at higher level punctuation. A non-chronological report detailing the river Nile from facts gathered from our history and geography lessons; this will allow children to focus on the geographical features of the Nile and using technical vocabulary. We will also be writing another non-chronological report/biography on the life of Howard Cater and a newspaper article on the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun. We will be focusing on the layout of newspaper articles and the language used.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be covering: Place value, which covers to read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000,000 and to understand the value of each digit. Addition and subtraction, which begins by being able to add and subtract mentally and using the formal written methods. This includes decimals and identifying missing numbers. Multiplying and division, focusing on using the formal written method of long multiplication and long division. We will also be focusing on short division and how to interpret remainders as a whole number reminder, fraction or by rounding. Once we have looked at all four operations we will move on to BODMAS, identifying common factors, multiples and prime numbers. This will them allow us to move on to their reasoning skills by solving multi-step problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.



Science




This term in Science we will be covering: The circulatory system, focusing on the heart, blood and blood vessels. With an emphasis on naming the parts of the human heart and how the heart operates. Then we will be writing an assessment pieces describing the function of the heart, blood vessels and blood. We will be focussing on the technical vocabulary used and what they mean. We will also be looking at a scientist named Charles Drew who was well known for research into the storage of blood and how blood transfusions worked.

History

This term in History we will be covering:

Ancient Egyptians with an emphasis on who they were. We will be looking into their beliefs, gods/goddesses, Tutankhamun and mummification. We will be writing an instructional piece detailing the process of mummification and the importance of it.



Geography



This term in Geography we will be covering:

The river Nile and the importance of it. We will be focusing on the geographical features, climate and mapping. This will allow us to look at technical vocabulary and analysing the world map.

D&T

This term in D&T we will be covering:

Places of worship and the significance it has on their community. We will be creating 3D models of places of worship, focusing on developing and annotating their sketches and designing a functional product that is fit for purpose.



Art



This term in Art we will be focusing on:

An artist named Leonard Da Vinci with an emphasis on his famous drawing 'The Vitruvian Man'. We will be focusing on the artistic techniques he used to create his drawing and children will have a chance to draw 'The Vitruvian Man' using the same techniques.

RE

This term in RE we will be covering:

Pilgrimages of many different religions and the importance of it in each faith.

Children should be able to understand to link different religions to their religious pilgrimages, and identify the difference and similarities between pilgrimages.





Computing

This term in Computing we will be covering:

- ICT skills including word processing.

This term in PE we will be covering:

- -Invasion games
