RE: Year 6 Educational Visit to the British Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to inform you that Year 6 are planning a trip to the British Museum for the children as part of our Egyptian topic this term. The British Museum holds a huge collection of Egyptian artefacts related to the afterlife, life along the River Nile and finally the world-famous Rosetta Stone, which Egyptologists used to decipher hieroglyphics.



Year 6 will be visiting the British Museum on **Tuesday 28th November**. We will be leaving school at approximately 9am and returning by approximately 3.00pm. We will update you via a text message if we will be returning later than 3.10pm due to traffic. Please ensure your child arrives at school at 8.40am on the day.

The children will require a packed lunch (no glass containers, fizzy drinks or chocolate products) contained in a named carrier bag, a waterproof jacket/coat and sensible shoes. School uniform must be worn. Please note that if you would like your child to be provided with a canteen packed lunch please speak to their class teacher about arranging this. If your child requires a travel sickness tablet for the trip, please ensure this is sent in to school to the Welfare room prior to the trip.

The cost of the visit, including travelling by coach, fitted with seat belts, will be **£8.75** per child. Payment for the trip should be made via Parent Pay by **Friday 17th November**. If insufficient money is collected through voluntary contributions, the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. You will be required to give consent through Parent Pay and you will be asked to do this before you pay. Please do not send any money into school for this trip.
