Dear Parents / Carers

RE: YEAR 4 EDUCATIONAL VISIT

As part of our topic on the Tudors, we have organised a trip to Hampton Court Palace on **Friday 24th November 2023**. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to visit an iconic British landmark and further embed their knowledge and understanding of the Tudor reign. During the trip, the children will be able to take part in a **Tudor Kitchens Workshop delivered by a costumed presenter**. They will learn about the foods cooked and consumed at the palace and the necessary roles required to deliver this.



We will be leaving school at approximately 9.15am and return by approximately 3.00pm. We will update you via a text message, if we will be returning later than 3.10pm due to traffic. **Please ensure your child arrives at school promptly at 8.40am on the day of the visit.**

The children will require a packed lunch (no glass containers, fizzy drinks or chocolate products) contained in a named carrier bag, a waterproof jacket/coat and sensible shoes. **School uniform must be worn**. If your child requires a travel sickness tablet for the trip please ensure this is sent in to school to the Welfare room prior to the trip.

The cost of the visit, travelling by coach (fitted with seat belts), and an exciting workshop will be **£17.80** per child. **Money for the trip should be paid via ParentPay by Friday 10th November**. If insufficient money is collected through voluntary contributions, the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. You will be required to give consent through ParentPay and you will be asked to do this before you confirm payment. Please do not send any money into school for this trip.
