A number of parents have reported that items have been misplaced and they are not named.

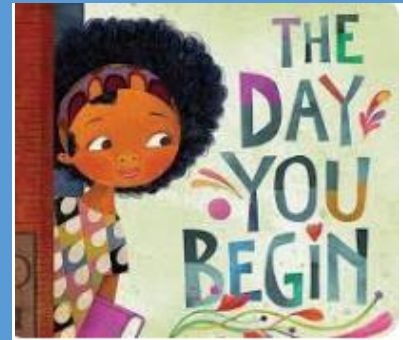
This makes it very difficult to return the correct uniform item to the right child.
