



Anti-Bullying Week 2023



Next week (Monday 13th to Friday 17th November) is national Anti Bullying Week and is an opportunity for us all to consider what bullying is and how to prevent it.

This year's theme is 'Make a Noise About Bullying' and in order to do so it is important that we all understand how we define bullying.

At Charville we have an Anti Bullying Policy, which was last approved by our Governors in spring term last year. The policy includes the definition of bullying, which is:

The repetitive and deliberate attempt of an individual or group to hurt, frighten or upset another person. The bully has a sense of satisfaction from hurting others.

Next week is an opportunity for all children and adults of our school community to understand this definition and how to address and deal with bullying if and when it occurs.

It is very important to stress that bullying can happen face to face but can also take place online and this is where schools need your help.

It is vital that all parents/ carers that allow their children to access social media. Including WhatsApp regularly monitor their activity and have adequate privacy settings in place.

Next week will begin with assembly based on Anti Bullying Week and what bullying is. There will be opportunities throughout the week to understand what to do if and when bullying, including online bullying occurs.

We will be selling official Anti Bullying wrist bands for £1 next week. Year 6 will be selling them to each class so please send your child in with £1 from Monday, if they would like one.
