Year 6 Educational Visit to RAF Hendon

Dear Parents / Carers,

On **Tuesday 6th February 2024** Year 6 will be visiting the RAF Museum in Hendon. This will be an informative visit that will form part of our World War 2 topic for the Spring term. It is a great opportunity for the children to learn the complete history of the RAF from the early days of flight, to the formation of the RAF in 1918, through to the present day. The museum has a stunning display of aircrafts and the children will also be participating in a workshop where they will experience what it was like be in a bunker during wartime.



We will be leaving school at approximately 9.00am and return by approximately 3.00pm. We will update you via a text message, if we will be returning later than 3.10pm due to traffic. **Please ensure your child arrives at school promptly at 8.40am on the day of the visit.**

The children will require a packed lunch (no glass containers, fizzy drinks or chocolate products) contained in a named carrier bag which can be disposed of, a waterproof jacket/coat and sensible shoes. **School uniform must be worn.** If you require the school to provide a school packed lunch, please notify your child's class teacher by **Friday 26th January 2024**. If your child requires any travel medications, then please ensure this is given at home in the morning and then inform Welfare of any medication that will be required for the return journey. This will need to be supplied the day before in a named envelope.

The cost of the trip is **£11.30** per child, which includes the cost of the coach (fitted with seatbelts) and the exciting bunker workshop. Please make the payment via ParentPay no later than **Friday 26th January 2024** If insufficient money is collected through voluntary contributions, the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. You will be required to give consent through ParentPay and you will be asked to do this before you confirm payment. Please do not send any money into school for this trip. If for any reason your child is unable to attend the trip on the day, we will not be able to give you a refund, as we have to make the payment prior to the visit.
