Charville Academy is very proud of our Arts department and extremely proud of all the children who enjoy working on extra-curricular instrument lessons or singing groups. We are very fortunate to have an excellent range of music staff, who offer group, paired and individual music lessons in a variety of instruments listed below.

Group and Individual lessons are during school time on a rotating timetable. It is expected that children continue lessons for the entire academic year and ideally through to year 6 in order to gain the most they possibly can from learning an instrument. A full term's notice is required for children to stop their lessons and no refunds will be made throughout the term. Accommodating children who are absent or on a school trip on a lesson day may be possible, but cannot be guaranteed.

Rates are as follows for an average of 10 lessons per term. Opportunities are for students in both Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.

There are limited places available for each instrument club and lessons are on a first come first served basis for new students. Continuing students will be given priority. Should the lesson be closed because it has reached capacity by the time you go to pay, please contact finance.

Payment is due no later than Friday 12th January, 2024

To reserve your place, log onto Parentpay, choose which instrument your child would like to learn and click to pay. The club will disappear from the system when they have reached capacity. If minimum numbers are not reached, the club will be withdrawn. Should this occur, you will be offered a place in another group or a refund.

Classes will commence the week beginning 15th January. Lesson days are as follows; Guitar, Drums - Tuesday, KS1 Singing – Rotating days and Piano – Thursday. These days are subject to change due to school events.
