RE: Year 5 Educational Visit to the Gurdwara

Dear Parents / Carers,

We are writing to inform you that Year 5 are planning a trip as part of our study of the Sikh faith this term.



Year 5 will be visiting the **Gurdwara Sri Guru Singh Sabha on Tuesday 27**th**/Wednesday 28**th**/Thursday 29th respectively (5D 27th, 5R 28th, 5M 29th).** We will be leaving school at approximately **11:15 am** and will be returning at approximately **2:45 pm**, within normal school hours (you will be advised of any delays by text). Children are required to wear their full school uniform including a coat. If a skirt is being worn then trousers or tights need to be worn underneath. Please ensure your child wears socks as shoes will need to be removed.

While in the Gurdwara pupils' hair will need to be covered. Head coverings are available from the Gurdwara, however, please supply your child with either a bandana or scarf that can be tied up to cover their hair. This applies to girls AND boys. We will have some spares available at school but they are limited.

We will be travelling via public transport/minibus, and as such if your child requires any travel medications then please ensure this is given at home in the morning and then inform welfare of any medication that will be required for the return journey. This will need to be supplied the day before in a named envelope.

Children will require a packed lunch in a named carrier bag which can be disposed of. We ask that you do not include glass bottles, fizzy drinks or chocolate products. Please note that if your child would like to have a school packed lunch, please speak to their class teacher by Friday 23rd. Meat, fish and egg are prohibited in the Gurdwara therefore if your child is bringing their own packed lunch, please ensure it is vegetarian.

There is no cost involved for this trip and it will would be a valuable educational experience to learn about how different cultures celebrate their faiths. Please complete the permission slip below and return it to your child's class teacher by Friday 23rd February alternatively permission can be given by logging on to ParentPay.
