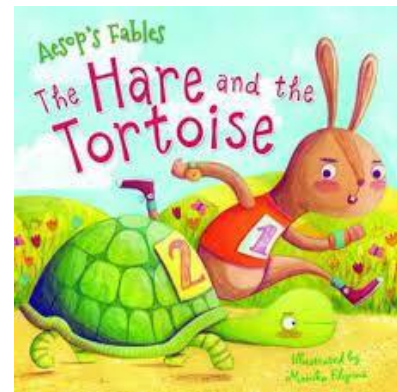
NURSERY SPORTS DAY

Nursery Sports Day will be taking place on **Friday 7th June 2024**.

There will be a morning and afternoon session.

The morning session commences at 10:00am and finishes at 11:10am. To support the 30-hour children, we ask that you leave the Nursery and collect your child from the Children's Centre gate as normal at 11:20am. **The afternoon session commences at 1:50pm and finishes at 3:00pm.** Once the session is finished, your child will be dismissed, by a member of staff, from the Nursery. All parents and carers are welcome to join us for this time. However, please ensure that your child does not have more than 2 adults in attendance.

Our theme for the day is 'The Tortoise and the Hare'. The children will need to wear shorts and a T-shirt with trainers. Welly boots will be needed for the puddles if the weather does not permit bare feet. **Water bottles and sun hats are essential.** Please ensure that your child has these on the day. Parents/carers should **apply sun cream in the morning / afternoon** prior to coming to school. If your child is a 30-hour child, please ensure that they have long lasting sun cream.



Our Sports Day will include races on the field followed by activities in the Nursery Garden. When arriving please use the entrance by the Children's Centre. On entry to Nursery, please take the sticker(s) with your child's name before the activities begin.

Once the races are complete, your child will then complete a circuit of activities with you. If your child is a 30-hour child, we would recommend that an adult attend both sessions as they will be taking part in both sessions (maximum of 2 adults per child).

In line with our school policy **no photographs or video footage can be taken by parents/carers.** If the school is made aware that parents are ignoring this request then you will be asked to delete any images that you have taken. We thank you in advance for your cooperation. There will be an opportunity to take a photo of your child at the end of the session.
