Parent Carer Survey

Thank you to all the parents and carers that have completed our recent Parent Survey. The questions were modelled on questions that families would be asked as part of any Ofsted inspection survey.

Questions asked were themed around Learning, teaching, wider opportunities, safeguarding and well being.

Our analysis of the responses has been completed and is summarised as follows:

90% of our parents and carers would consider recommending our school to others.

94% of parents and carers that completed the survey have taken up a place at an after school club, which reflects the uptake of club provision that we have experienced.

82% of parents and carers think that we offer a wide range of subjects.

In response to this we are considering how to improve the way in which we communicate our broad and balanced curriculum to our families.

82% of parents and carers strongly agree or agree that we keep them informed of how well their child is doing.

In direct response to this we are considering how best to ensure that parents and carers are kept up to date with their child's learning.
