A huge well done to Cian in Year 3 who raised the largest amount.

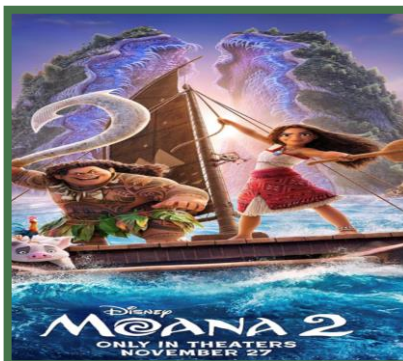
