We are also selling merchandise and holding a Pudsey Bear raffle during the week of the 10th November. Please see the letter, which we will issue on Monday 3rd November.





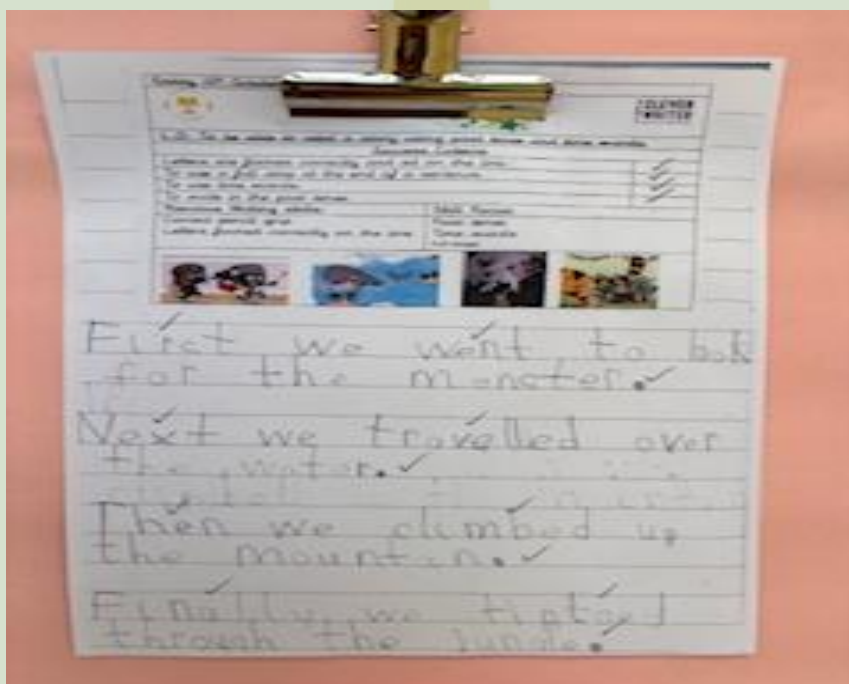
Star Write
