I would like to take this opportunity to make you aware of the latest update from the government regarding school attendance. This government has issued new information for schools regarding improving school attendance, which is a national issue. One of the main changes is that parents and carers can now be referred for fining if the child has 10 unauthorised absences in a 10 week period. It is important to note that schools are required to include unauthorised lateness into these figures. Please note that the fine (if issued) is £80 per parent per child and this includes families that do not reside together.
