We are really pleased to welcome you all to our new data management system.

Arbor is an online App that will enable you to view your child's profile on your device.

Work is underway to move all our letter, text and email communication to Arbor and we will also be moving all meal and payment information to the App.

On Wednesday we issued a parent/ carer letter that included the link needed to activate your child's account. **This must be done by Friday 19th December.**

Please note, that in spring term **we will no longer be able to issue barcode letters or accept cash payments** as Arbor does not have this facility. If you currently rely on barcodes and pay cash you will need to move over to online payments via the App.
