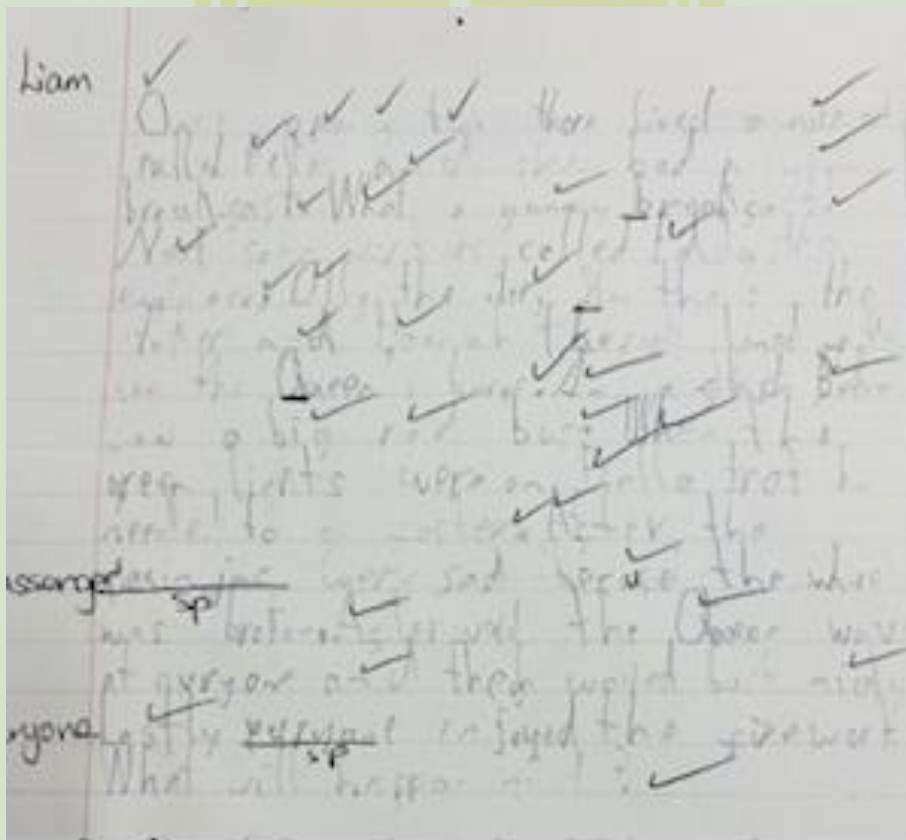

Arbor Update

Thank you to the **98%** of families that have activated their Arbor account and downloaded the APP. Please note that it is important to download the APP and not access Arbor via a browser as this only provides limited access. Once you have downloaded the APP, please make sure you enable the notifications or you will not be aware of any communications.

The next step is to move all our communications, trip and club management as well as payment to Arbor and this will be different to our previous system.

In the past we have been able to support parents who missed communications about clubs and trips and allow people to sign up after the deadline. Arbor does not enable this. Once an event has closed we are not able to access it so will not be able to support parents that miss the deadline.

Parents' Evening on the 27th March will also be managed via the Arbor APP. All appointments will be on this evening and we will not be making separate appointments so please have this date in your diary. The slots will be allocated on a first come first served basis so once that slot is gone it will not be a case of making an appointment at that time on another evening as we are no longer able to offer that.
