Arbor Update

Thank you once again to all the families that have activated their Arbor account and downloaded the APP. Please note that it is important to download the APP and not access Arbor via a browser as this only provides limited access. Once you have downloaded the APP, please make sure you enable the notifications or you will not be aware of any communications.

The next step is to move all our communications, trip and club management as well as payment to Arbor and this will be different to our previous system.

In the past we have been able to support parents who missed communications about clubs and trips and allow people to sign up after the deadline. Arbor does not enable this. Once an event has closed we are not able to access it so will not be able to support parents that miss the deadline.
