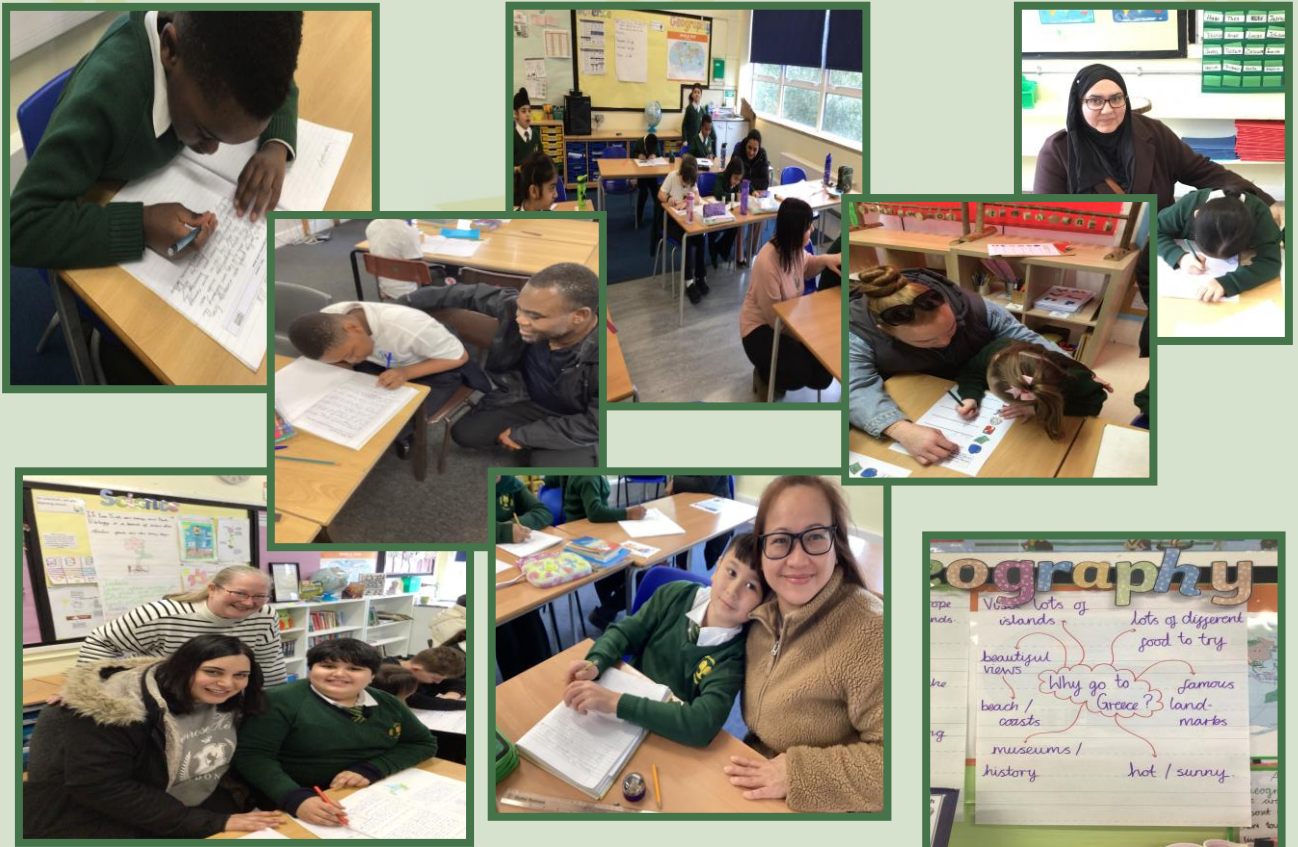
I Am A Clever Writer Showcase
