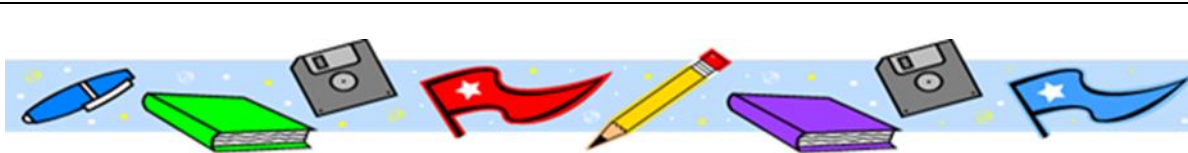




Pastoral Support Service

To provide children with an opportunity to discuss their worries or concerns outside of the classroom.

What do we do?

The Pastoral Team works in partnership with our parents/carers to improve all children's learning, attendance, behaviour and emotional well-being. We can support children who may have:

- Learning needs and barriers to learning
- Support with attendance
- Special Educational Needs
- English as an Additional Language
- Gifts or Talents
- Behavioural Needs
- Bereavement and separation and loss
- Transition support
- Worries or concerns in general
- Friendship concerns, or low self-esteem

The Pastoral Team can support parents/carers with:

- Pastoral Support Meetings
- Links to Family Support through the Children Centre for under –fives.
- Links to parenting support services in Hillingdon.
- Housing and benefits advice.
- Information about the courses at the Children Centre to aid their child's learning.
