

Curriculum Booklet

Year 6 – Summer 2026

English



This term in English we will be covering: Writing a non-chronological report detailing a new animal in the style of Fantastic Beasts with an emphasis on character traits/behaviour, appearance and origin. We will be including descriptive language and higher-level vocabulary and punctuation. We will be reading our key text 'Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban' and writing a narrative piece based on the train scene, from which Harry is attacked by a dementor. We will be focusing on suspense writing and using descriptive techniques when describing the dementor.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be covering: Geometry where children will be focusing on investigating and drawing angles in a square and rectangle. Position and movement which covers coordinates, describing translation, movements and reflections.

They will be solving problems with quadrilaterals and investigating regular polygons. Measurements which covers exploring the measurement of mass, temperature, time and length. Once this is covered, this will allow us to move on to their reasoning skills and solving worded problems involving geometry, measurement and position and movement. We will continue doing maths retrieval lesson which involved revisiting topics learnt in autumn and spring term.



Science



This term in Science we will be covering: Evolution and inheritances through our scientist and inventors Francis Crick, James Watson and Charles Darwin. We will be looking at fossils and adaptation. We will also be covering living things and their habitat.

History



This term in History we will be covering:
The story of King Arthur and where it originated from. We will be evaluating if the story was a myth and looking into Arthurian legends. We will be exploring the importance of knights and the weapons they used and discussing why they no longer exists.

Geography

This term in Geography, Year 6 will be learning about Climate Change and creating a speech about something that we are passionate about regarding this topic. They will also be completing their own independent project based on a country of their choice.



D&T



Art

This term in D&T we will be covering:
Upcycling - Fashion through the ages.

This term in Art, we will be covering Salvador Dali and Paul Klee focusing on surrealism. We will be analysing some of Salvador Dali's most famous surrealist painting. We will be looking at Paul Klee's painting 'Around the Fish' with an emphasis on the techniques used, effects of the background and unpicking the meanings of the objects surrounding the fish. We will also be looking at symbolism focusing on Edvard Munch and his composition 'The Scream'. Towards the end of the term, we will be looking at Aerial photography with a particular focus on Georg Gerster; looking at aerial viewpoints and comparing and contrasting photograph taken by Georg Gerster.





This term in RE we will be covering:
How the universe was created and looking at this from a scientific and religious perspective. Focusing on 'The Big Bang Theory' and Charles Darwin as well as what other religion creation stories such as Christianity, Islam, Sikhism etc. We will also be having discussion around afterlife.

Computing

This term in Computing we will be covering:
Creating Media – 3D modelling. During this unit, children will develop their knowledge and understanding of using a computer to produce 3D models. They will then create hollow objects using placeholders and combine multiple objects to create a model of a desk tidy.
Programming – Sensing movement. This unit is the final KS2 programming unit and brings together elements of all the programming constructs. It offers pupils the opportunity to use all of these constructs in a different, but still familiar environment.



This term in PE we will be covering:
Net and ball games and athletics.

Music

This term in music we will be practising for the Year 6 musical which is Grimm.





In French this term, the children will be learning to:

- Say different colours
 - Name animals
