



# Curriculum Booklet

## Year 3 – Summer 2026

### English



In summer 1, the children will write retells, a diary entry, an explanation, a letter and poetry.

In Summer 2, the children will write a setting description, a retell, a formal letter and a non-chronological report.

This term will introduce using the present perfect tense and consolidating previously taught skills.

### Maths

In Summer 1, the children will cover different units of measure including: length, mass and volume. They will then revisit the four number operations using money and deepen their knowledge on Time.

In Summer 2, the children will continue on with Time where they will focus on problem solving before moving onto data handling, angles, perimeter and shape.



### Science



In Summer 1 we will be learning about plants as part of our animals and living things topic. Our significant individual will be George Washington Carver.

In Summer 2, we will move onto looking at living things and their habitats relating to the animals of the rainforest. Our significant individuals will be Rachel Carson and Maria Sibylla Merian.

## History



There is no History for this term as we will be focusing on Geography.

## Geography

In Geography, the learning will focus on the water cycle and move onto learning about tropical rainforest biomes.

We will then move our learning onto the Amazon River and South America.

## Art

This term, we will focus on Art.

In Art, the children will learn about Henri Rousseau (In the Jungle) and Hurvin Anderson (Maracas IX study). These paintings relate to our topic of rainforest.

We will then move onto Pop Art where we will look at the Brazilian pop artist Lobo.





In Summer 1, we will learn about the Islamic festival of Eid before moving onto Sikh beliefs.

In Summer 2, we will focus on Hindu beliefs..

## Computing

In Computing, Year 3 will be creating media through desktop publishing where they will learn all about creating a magazine cover using a range of skills.

Then, the children will build upon their coding knowledge from Spring 1 to learn to use 'event' and 'action' commands in programs.



## Music

This term in PE we will be covering:

- Cricket
- Athletics

In Music, the children will continue with their learning with recorders.





In French, the children will learn how to talk about their family members and continue on with their learning on numbers.

## Home Learning
