RE: Year 6 Cinema and Bowling trip

Friday 1st May 2026

Dear Parents / Carers,

As part of our end of year celebrations, we have organised a special trip for Year 6 to the cinema and bowling alley on **Thursday 2nd July 2026**. This trip will take place during the school day and is a wonderful opportunity for the children to celebrate their time at primary school, relax with their peers and create lasting memories before moving on to secondary school. The children will enjoy watching a film at the cinema followed by a fun bowling session.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9:00am and returning by approximately 3pm. We will update you via Arbor if we will be returning later than 3pm due to any delays. **Please ensure your child arrives at school promptly at 8:30am on the day of the visit so we can leave on time.**

Children will be getting lunch at the bowling alley, so children will not need to bring a packed lunch. Class teachers will take lunch choices 2 weeks prior to the trip.

The lunch options are as follows:

- Option 1: Plain beef burger and chips (halal option available)
- Option 2: Plain veggie burger and chips
- Option 3: Plain chicken burger and chips (halal option available)
- Option 4: Hot dog and chips (halal option available)
- Option 5: Chicken nuggets and chips (halal option available)
- Option 6: Margherita pizza twist served without chips

We recommend that the children bring a water bottle so that they stay hydrated throughout the day. School uniform must be worn, alongside sensible shoes. As we will be travelling via public transport, if your child requires a travel sickness tablet, please ensure this is brought into school and sent to the Welfare room prior to the trip.

The cost of the visit will be **£12.40 per child**. This is to cover the cost of the cinema ticket, bowling session and lunch. Money for the trip should be paid via Arbor by Thursday 21st May 2026. If insufficient money is collected through voluntary contributions, the trip will, unfortunately, have to be cancelled and the children will miss out on this special end of year experience. You will be



required to give consent through Arbor, and you will be asked to do this before you confirm payment. Please do not send any money into school for this trip.
