Dear Parents and Carers,

Our school is taking part in Walk to School Week from Monday 18th May- Friday 22nd May. This nationwide event is organised by the walking charity Living Streets and designed to help pupils experience first-hand the importance of walking to school. Children will be well on their way to reaching their recommended minimum 60 minutes of physical activity per day before even reaching the school gates. Not only will it set them up for a positive day in the classroom, but it will also help create healthy habits for life.



This year's challenge, Mission Move, encourages children to travel actively to school every day of the week (this includes walking, cycling, scooting or park and stride). Each day pupils will learn about the important reasons to walk or wheel and its benefits for individuals, communities and the environment.

Each pupil will be challenged to travel sustainably (walk, wheel, scoot, cycle or park and stride) to school every day for one week, using wallcharts to log their journeys. Each class will work collectively to make as many active journeys to school as possible across the week.

By walking, cycling or scooting to school you're not only exercising but also helping our school reduce congestion and pollution around the school gates. Walking, wheeling, scooting and cycling all count. If you live far away from school and need to drive or take public transport, you could even try parking the car or hopping off the bus ten minutes away and walking the rest of the journey.
