Reception and KS1 Sports Day

We will be having our annual **Reception and KS1 Sports Day** on **Tuesday 16th June**. All parents/carers are invited to attend the afternoon session between 1.30pm and 3.00pm. We ask that attendees **arrive no earlier than 1:15**, that way you can be positioned in-time for the races to commence.

As **all** pupils will be participating in this event, they are expected to arrive at school in their full PE kit that is appropriate for the weather. Children will remain in this kit for the duration of the school day; thus, no change of clothes is necessary. Children should wear a t-shirt which represents their house colours, as there will be many team events. The children know what house they are in.

The colour t-shirts needed are:

Kingshill - Red

Langdale - Yellow

Grosvenor - Green

Bury – Blue

We hope the weather for this event will be good. To ensure that the children do not dehydrate throughout the morning, they are all **required** to bring water with them which should be in a named, plastic bottle. We are extremely conscious of sunburn and heat stroke. On this day, please ensure that you provide your child with a **hat** (preferably one that protects the neck). **Sun cream should be applied to your child before they come into school.**

For health and safety reasons, please refrain from approaching your child during the course of the afternoon. An allocated area will be available for parents/carers to watch their children’s races and we ask that you do not approach or cross the running track at any stage.

In line with our school policy **no photographs or video footage can be taken by parents/carers**. If the school is made aware that parents are ignoring this request then you will be asked to delete any images that you have taken. We thank you in advance for your co-operation.

Please can we remind parents/visitors about the parking restrictions outside the school gates. Access to the playing field will be via the gates next to the Children’s Centre.

Parents/carers will be advised by Arbor, the night before, if the event is cancelled due to bad weather forecast. This is to prevent short notice being given on the day. The event will be arranged for another date.
