A special mention to Amelia, Rukaya, Khloe, Eden, Micah and Harley!


We were crowned London Hockey Champions for the first time, Congratulations!

## Arbor Emails - Junk Box

Emails delivered to Junk/SPAM Mailbox - Hotmail/Outlook/Live email addresses

We have been working with our IT support teams to try to resolve the issues with emails from Arbor delivering to parents Junk/SPAM mail box.

If you are having an issue, please follow the instructions below to add Arbor as a safe sender.

Parents can bypass the spam filters applied by their provider by adding Arbor to their Safe Senders list. Because mobile apps often lack this feature, they should use a desktop or mobile browser.

- 1. Log In:** Go to Outlook.com on a computer or mobile web browser
- 2. Settings:** Click the **Settings (gear icon)** in the top right corner and select **View all Outlook settings**
- 3. Safe Senders:** Navigate to **Mail > Junk email**
- 4. Add Address:** Under **Safe senders and domains**, click **+ Add safe sender** and type exactly: [no-reply@mail.arbor-education.com](mailto:no-reply@mail.arbor-education.com)
- 5. Save:** Click **Save**
- 6. Not Junk:** If an email is already in the Junk folder, open it and click **Not junk** to train the filter
