Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing with regard to the forecast of extremely high temperatures this week. We would like to make a few temporary adjustments to help keep all children safe and comfortable during the school day.

Children may wear shorts and t-shirts instead of their usual school uniform for the remainder of the week if they wish. No flip flops to be worn. We also ask that all children come to school with:

- Sun cream applied before arriving at school
- A hat or cap for outdoor activities
- A clearly named water bottle containing plenty of water

Classes have been moved so they have access to air conditioning.

From tomorrow, Nursery will only be open to children attending for 30hrs for the remainder of this week.

Please note that Music and PE will be adapted so that the fully air-conditioned Music studio can be accessed by Reception classes. PE sessions will be class based and focused on healthy living.

All lunch times and break times will include very limited time outside.

To minimise exposure to the heat, our planned Cross-Country event scheduled for Wednesday 24th June has been cancelled. A new date will be arranged, and we will update you as soon as this has been confirmed.

This evening's football match will go ahead as planned. However, additional measures will be in place to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all participants. Water breaks will take place every 10 minutes, and gazebos, water and ice pops will be provided to offer shade and protection from the sun as well as hydration.



After school clubs will still take place but adapted to limit physical activities.

We will continue to monitor the weather closely and make any further adjustments as necessary.
