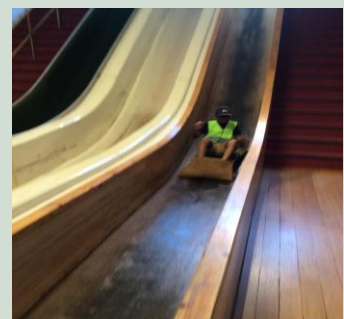
We held our heads, scored and saved some great penalties and were crowned Champions of Hayes & Harlington!
